CEO CORNER

Welcome back to another CEO corner for 2021 and the big wet continues. Ongoing thanks to all community members for their patience and understanding with the multiple road closures that have occurred in recent weeks due to the significant rainfall and runoff events. As mentioned previously, Shire staff do not take the closing of roads lightly and the reasons are twofold; one to protect the integrity of the road and two: more importantly for the safety of road users and the public. A huge thanks to Judd and the crew, who continue to be flat out dealing with the many road closures and reopening throughout the Shire, as well as assisting Main Roads with their closures.

Plenty is still happening around town even with the weather wreaking havoc with our projects.

- Footpath upgrades along Gordon, Day and Stewart Streets are nearly complete with new concrete as well as strategically placed pram and gopher ramps. Moving forward further works are scheduled for Price Street and finalising additional pram ramps in specific locations.
- Pool repair works are nearing completion. Thanks to Dynamic Pools who have been the contractor on this. The weather has certainly messed them around, but

the retiling will hopefully be finished in the next fortnight.

- The All Ages Precinct commenced last week and is quickly taking shape. The skate park is the first component being delivered and the ramps are well under construction. Landscape Australia is the contractor working closely with Shire staff.
- FRC Court replacement is due to commence on Monday, 23rd August, squeezing this in between Netball and basketball seasons. This will be delivered via Aurasports.

The Volunteer Bushfire Brigade will be holding their AGM in Pingaring on 31st August. All FCOs are encouraged to attend and talk to myself about taking up additional responsibilities this year, with a few vacant positions. The Kulin Town Volunteer Fire Brigade have also scheduled a clean-up of the parking and picnic area of Jilakin Rock, this will take place on Sunday 22nd August. Community volunteers are welcome to come along and assist brigade members. А BBO and refreshments be provided will afterwards, thanks to Craig McInnes and the crew for organising this.

It is just under 2 months until the Kulin Bush Races and how crazy was it to see the event sold out to the public within 12 hours. Plenty of hard work and planning for the committee and community volunteers in the next 8 weeks. Shire staff will be assisting with sale of merchandise and volunteer tickets, which is always a pleasure working with the KBR team.

August brings out winter sports finals and Kulin rises to the top. Congratulations to the KKHC Vipers on winning 3 out of 4 in the GF, how good were the kids winning 8-1, the B Grade casually cruised to a 3-0 win, whilst the men won their first premiership in 20 years with a crushing 4-0 win. Well done to the Kulin Netball Club on hosting the CDNA Semi Finals last Saturday. This week sees the KKFC Blues commence their finals hosting the 1st Semi at Kondinin. Good luck to all. Next weekend is also the Kulin Golf Club's Annual Clayton Cup, with the course looking a treat hopefully they get a big field.

I'll continue with the good news in saying that this week Council's Rate Notices were distributed with a modest increase of 2.1%, this is in line with our Long-Term Financial Plan. The Valuer General obviously made this a challenge this year with property values around the district having a significant increase in some locations.

Dear CRC Operator

I am writing to advise you about the \$500 <u>WA Small Business and Charities Electricity</u> <u>Credit</u>.

WA businesses and charities may be eligible to receive a \$500 credit to put towards their electricity costs. The credit is a WA Government initiative to offset the impacts of a mandatory 5-day lockdown in February 2021.

Small businesses and charities on an eligible tariff as at 2 February 2021 already received a \$500 credit to their Synergy or Horizon Power account. Businesses and charities who are billed by third parties and meet the scheme criteria are able to apply to RevenueWA for an equivalent payment. This includes businesses and charities with premises on an embedded network, sub-meter, supplied by an alternate energy supplier or otherwise billed by a third party.

Applications are now open and will close **30 September 2021**.






