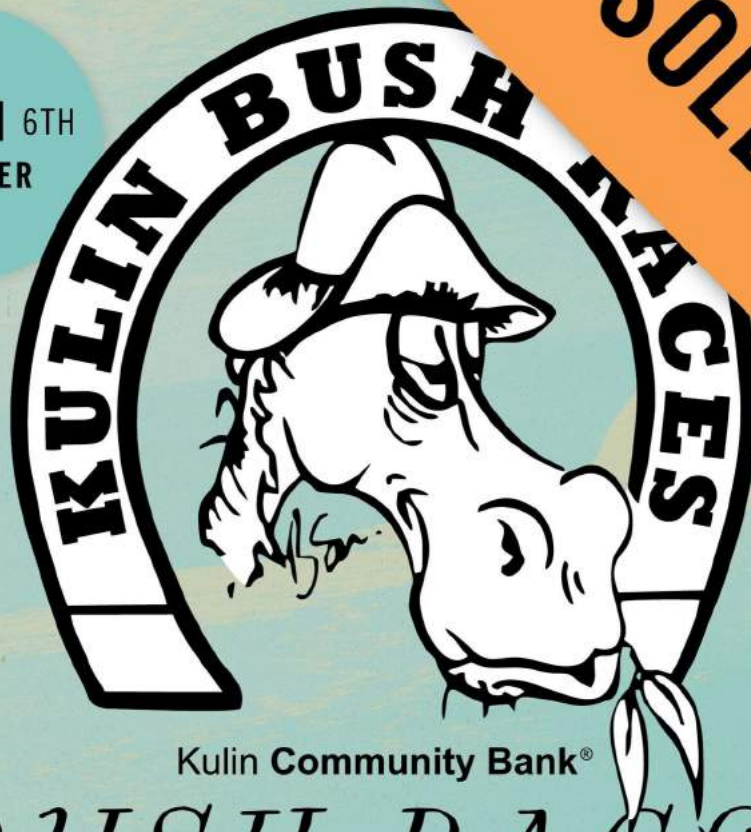

Untidy Blocks



With the advent of spring and the annual Bush Races many visitors will be coming to our town for a multitude of reasons, not the least being we are quite simply a fantastic place to be at.

With the above in mind the Shire, on behalf of all those residents who do the right thing, appeal to all to set aside some time to clean up around your home and in particular make the effort now to get rid of potential fire hazards that will exist once the grasses dry off. There is also the issue that long grass and rubbish makes an ideal home for snakes and other unwanted pests.

In past years the Council has not seriously considered issuing infringements; however this year there will be no warnings given to anyone not complying with the firebreak order. **Firebreaks must be done by 31st October 2019.**

The section of the firebreak order that applies to townsite land is as follows:

“Land Area less than 1 hectare:-

- All hazardous material must be removed from the whole of the land except living trees, shrubs and plants. In the remaining area all vegetation is to be maintained to a height of no greater than 100mm, and;
- It is recommended that at least a 2m wide area, immediately within the external boundaries of the lot, be clear of all flammable material except for living trees, plants and shrubs.”

For information any land of one hectare or above the rural provisions apply.

VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION STICKERS

Shire of Kulin's Bushfire Brigade AGM agreed to investigate and arrange for supply of DFES VIS (Vehicle Identification Stickers) to be issued to all relevant Brigade members with appliances and all Fire Control Officers. These stickers on vehicles and water tanks allow bushfire personnel to pass WA Police road blocks when attending a fire incident. On those occasions when WA Police have been requested to create a road block – they are required not to let any personnel through. Instances where fire respondents have also been turned away from assisting in fire control measures resulted in DFES and WA Police adopting a sticker based system to ensure the correct vehicles are allowed entry.

The Shire has now obtained stickers which expire in Sept 2020. These are available by collection from the Shire Office, please call in to collect yours from Trish when you are next in town.

Bushfire Brigade Update

Bush Fires Act 1945 - Notice to all Owners and/or Occupiers of Land within the Shire of Kulin

PURSUANT TO THE POWERS contained in Section 33, you are hereby required on or before 31st October 2019 and thereafter up to and including 15th March 2020 to have a 3 metre firebreak clear of all inflammable material on all rural and ~~townsite~~ rural land owned or occupied by you:

1. Immediately inside all external boundaries of the land; and
2. In such other positions as is necessary to divide land into areas not exceeding 500 hectares, each completely surrounded by a firebreak; and
3. Immediately surrounding any part of land used for crop; and
4. Parallel to and within 100 metres of the perimeter of all buildings, haystacks and fuel ramps on the land; and
5. Immediately surrounding receptacles used for the storage of fuel, whether they contain fuel or not; the firebreak required to comply with this item shall be no less than 5 metres wide; and
6. Immediately inside land which has been bulldozed, chained or prepared for clearing by burning (whether you intend to burn the bush or not); the firebreak required shall be no less than 7 metres wide. Where the land is prepared for clearing by burning after 19th September 2019 you shall provide the firebreak immediately.

Burning Periods

The RESTRICTED burning period commences on Thursday 19 September through to Thursday 31 October 2019. Effectively this means that no burning can be carried out unless you have a permit from your local Fire Control Officer. The exception is burning rubbish and garden refuse after 6pm (needs to be extinguished by 11pm). Other conditions apply.

PROHIBITED burning will commence on 1 November through to 15 February during which time **NO BURNING** is to take place within the Shire of Kulin.

Protective Clothing

Council will once again subsidise 50% of the cost of Full Face Respirators & Filters (full cost is approx. \$300). Fire fighting jackets and trousers can also be ordered through the Shire (no subsidy available). Estimated costs at this stage are \$125 for jackets and \$80 for trousers.

A duty of care exists for a Fire Control Officer to ensure that persons attending an incident has appropriate PPE (personal protective equipment), the same responsibility rests with those attending so please ensure you wear the required clothing, otherwise insurance issues may arise.

- It is the landowner's responsibility to ensure that they check with a Fire Control Officer, the Shire Office or the Harvest Ban Information line (9880 1511) if they have any doubt whatsoever on whether a harvest and vehicle movement ban should be in place.
- The Council accepts no responsibility should your mobile number be omitted, deleted or otherwise not listed as a contact at any time and for whatever reason.

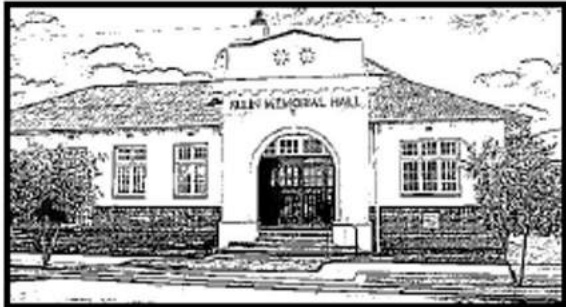

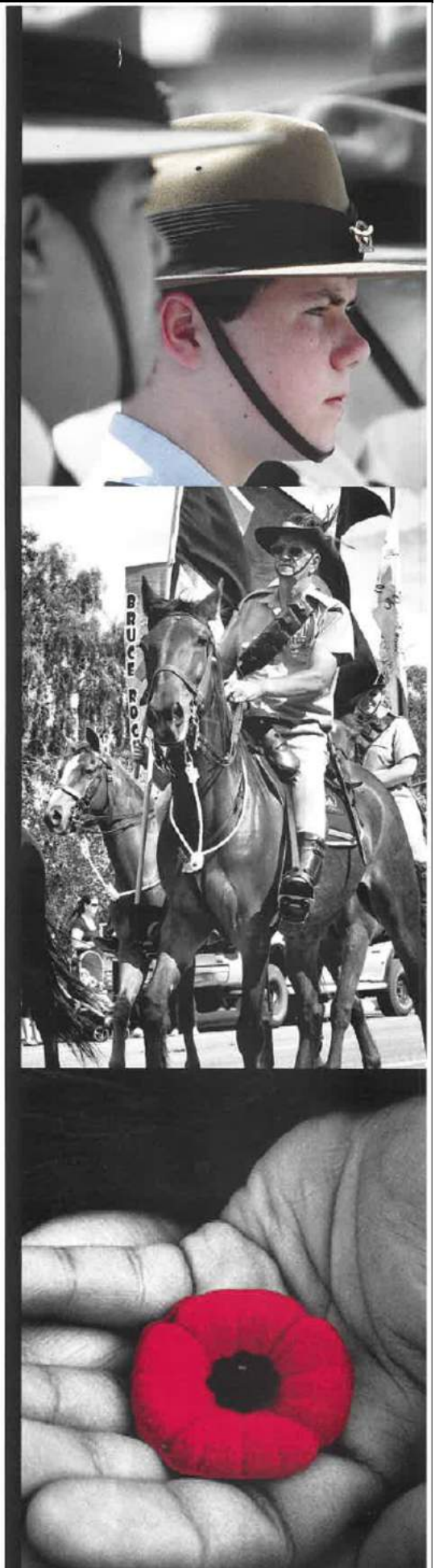

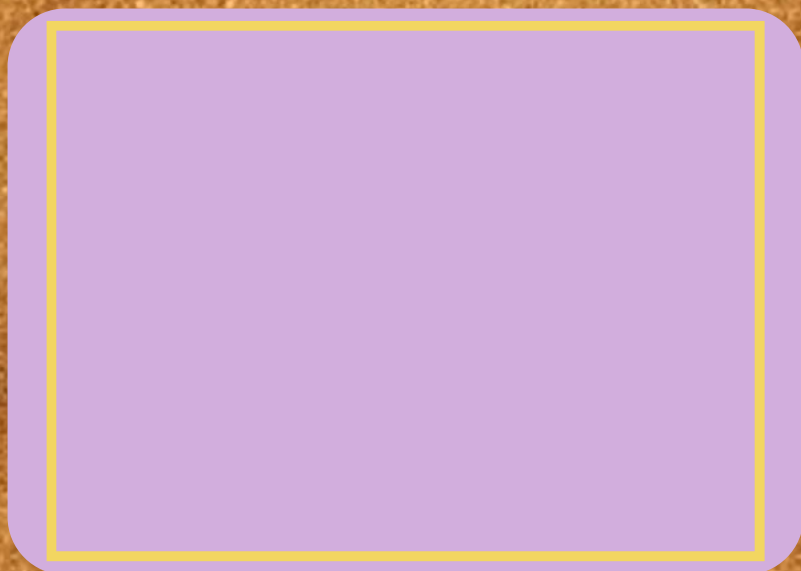
