In February 2016 when the community held a Kulin Bush Races (KBR) strategic planning workshop, one of the suggestions was to again separate KBR from the Shire of Kulin and re-establish the Kulin Bush Races Inc. There were a number of reasons for the proposal; difficulties meeting Local Government accounting and compliance measures was the biggest issue and the separation was seen as a means of developing a future direction that wasn't as reliant on the Shire.

It has taken some time and a lot of work in both KBR and Shire, but I can now inform all that the Kulin Bush Races Inc. was re-established on the 23rd April 2018. The official changeover dates will be the 30th June 2018 as there are still accounting, taxation and insurance issues to resolve but what was planned has now come to fruition.

I am sure the relationship between Shire and KBR Inc. will grow and grow under the new arrangements and KBR Inc. will become the flexible and responsive organisation it needs to be as it charts progress in the ever changing business environment.

Congratulations to all players who contributed to this milestone change.

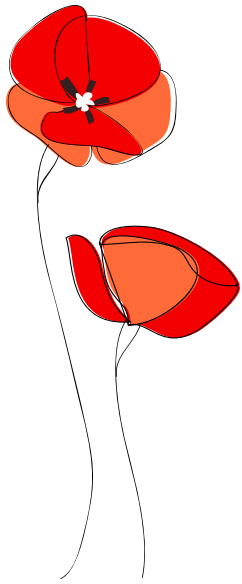

CAT & DOG OVERDUE 2017 REGISTRATIONS AND NEW REGISTRATIONS

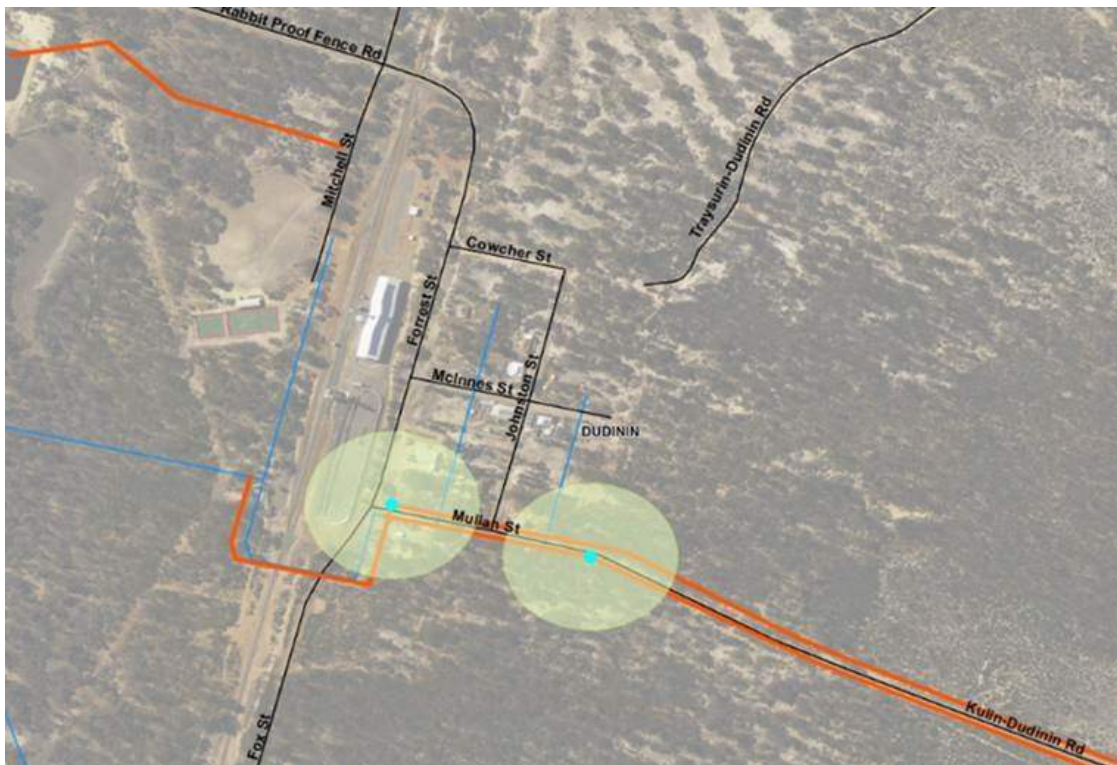

Water Corporation: Hydrant Infill in the Shire of Kulin

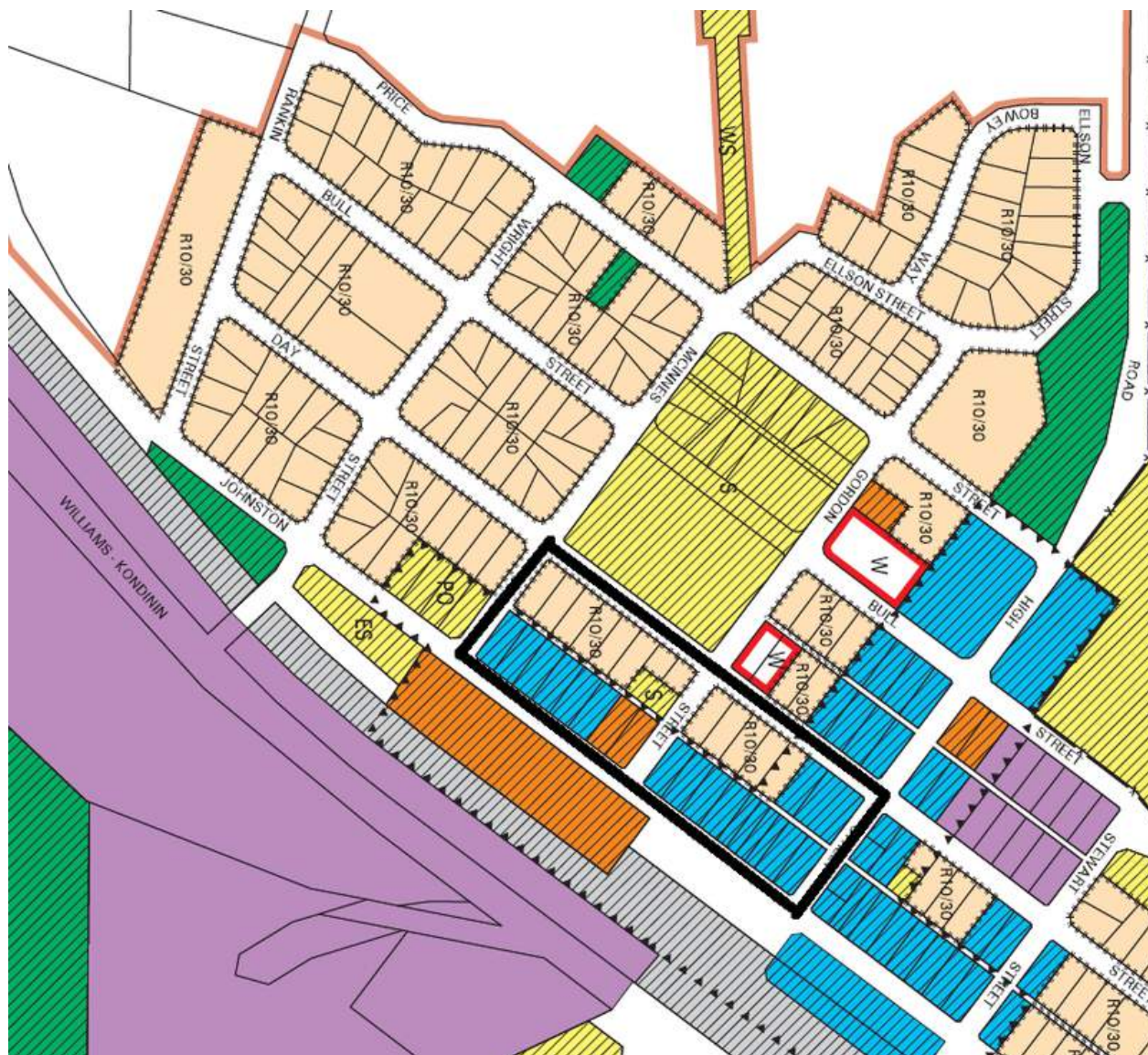
The map below shows the final locations of the 2 hydrants to be installed in Dudinin. Construction of these hydrants is planned to commence mid-2018





FOR INFORMATION - WATER CORPORATION - SHIRE WORKS

Please be advise that works to install a new water pipe will begin next Tuesday the 1st of May 2018 and continue for approx. 3 weeks. The new water pipe will be installed in the laneway between IGA and the Kulin Childcare Centre. There will be no rear access available via the lane during this time. The map below (the black box) shows the properties affecting by the works.





Allen Racks Road - Kulin

These photos are from a recent section On Allen Racks road in the Shire of Kulin that was treated with PolyCom Stabilising Agent. PolyCom comes as a granulated form that is spread over the road. Once water is added it reacts to form a stabilising agent that binds the dirt particles in a stronger form than normal water. It will reduce dust to a degree and less maintenance grades will be required over time.

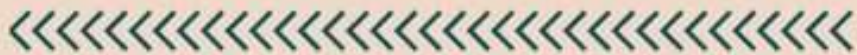

Apple Raspberry Pies

Ingredients

2 pink lady apples, halved, cored, thinly sliced
2 tablespoons caster sugar
2 teaspoons lemon juice
3 sheets frozen puff pastry, partially thawed
1/2 cup raspberry jam
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
20g butter, melted
1 tablespoon icing sugar
300ml thickened cream, whipped, to serve



Method

Step 1: Place apple, sugar, juice and 1/3 cup water in a saucepan over medium heat. Cook, stirring occasionally, for 5 minutes or until apple is just tender. Using a slotted spoon, transfer apple to a bowl. Set aside for 5 minutes to cool.

Step 2: Preheat oven to 180C/160C fan-forced. Grease a 12-hole (1/3-cup-capacity) muffin pan.

Step 3: Cut each sheet of pastry into 4 equal strips. Place 1 strip of pastry on a flat surface, with 1 long edge closest to you. Spread with 2 teaspoons jam. Sprinkle with a little of the cinnamon. Arrange a few apple slices, skin-edge up, overlapping slightly, with tops of apple overhanging at top edge of pastry. Fold bottom edge of pastry over the apple, leaving the tops exposed. Working from 1 short edge, roll up pastry to form a scroll. Place, apple-side up, into hole of prepared pan. Repeat with remaining pastry strips, jam, cinnamon and apple slices.

Step 4: Brush pies with butter. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes or until pastry is golden and puffed. Stand in pan for 5 minutes. Carefully transfer to a baking paper-lined wire rack. Stand for 10 minutes. Dust with icing sugar. Serve pies warm or cold with whipped cream.

Ingredients

1 1/2 cups milk
1 egg
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
2 cups self-raising flour
1/4 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
1/3 cup caster sugar
25g butter, melted

Homemade Pancakes

Breakfast in bed!



Method

Step 1: Whisk milk, egg and vanilla together in a jug. Sift flour and bicarbonate of soda into a bowl. Stir in sugar. Make a well in centre. Add milk mixture. Whisk until just combined.

Step 2: Heat a large non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Brush pan with butter. Using 1/4 cup mixture per pancake, cook 2 pancakes for 3 to 4 minutes or until bubbles appear on surface. Turn and cook for 3 minutes or until cooked through. Transfer to a plate. Cover loosely with foil to keep warm. Repeat with remaining mixture, brushing pan with butter between batches. Serve

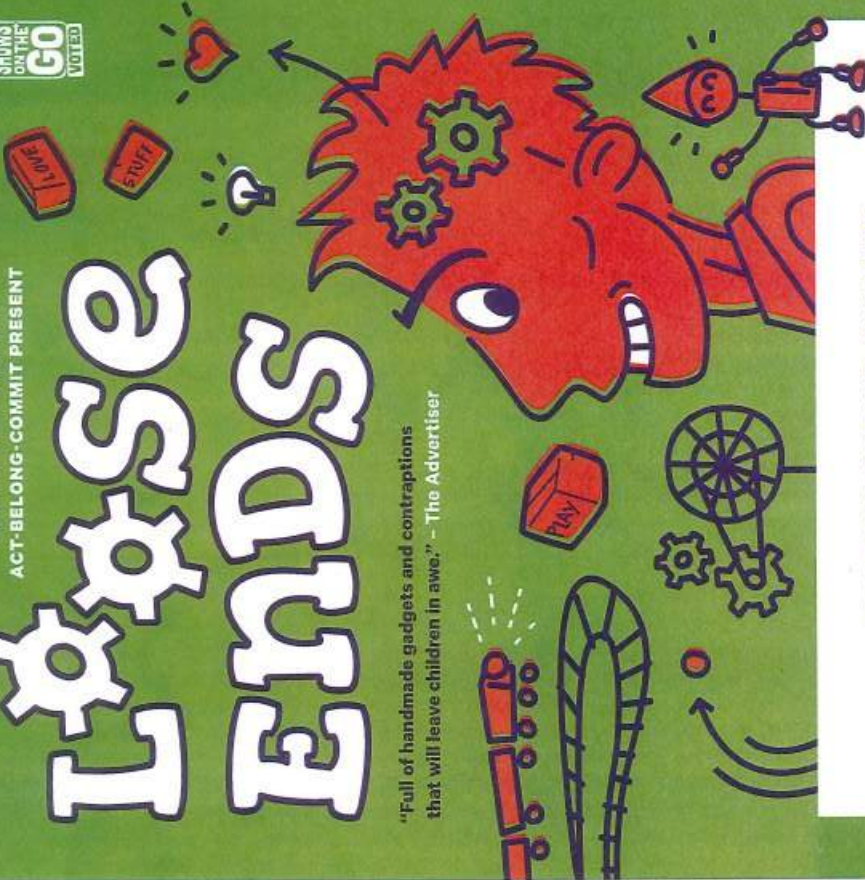
