# CEO CORNER

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Welcome back to another CEO corner for 2021, we've seen a few more stretches of fine weather as well as the uncertainty of COVID19 continue to rear its head. Vaccinations available in Kondinin this week provide an opportunity for us as a community to prepare as best we can for the inevitable of living with potentially more COVID cases in the coming months. Most roads within the Shire have now reopened, but motorists are still advised to drive with caution according to conditions.

The first component of the All Ages Precinct continues to take shape at a rapid pace. The skate zone should be nearing completion in the next fortnight with early works already commencing on the pump track. Stage 1 will hopefully be completed by the end of October. Last week Council approved the final design and budget for Stage 2, which will hopefully be funded by a Lotterywest grant. Finalised designs will be published in the coming weeks.

The fine weather has seen the pool repair works continue and they are nearing completion at the end of this week.

We are awaiting on confirmation regarding FRC Court resurfacing. The contractor is Queensland based and are having challenges entering WA due to COVID border restrictions. Fingers crossed they can get into the state and commence works in early September.

Last week Council also approved a Community Support and Recreation Facility Fund submission to upgrade the Kulin Oval lights to LED. This application is due in September, so hopefully it is successful with funding being released early in the new year for works to commence.

Thanks immensely to the Kulin Town Volunteer Fire Brigade on coordinating the clean-up of the parking and picnic area of Jilakin Rock last Sunday. Over 20 volunteers assisted in this and feedback from Cr Bowey is the area is looking much better. Thanks to Craig McInnes and the crew for organising this.

The Kulin Bush Races is fast approaching and a few volunteer rosters are already circulating. Shire staff are working with the KBR Committee to approve their event application and ensuring compliance in this

bureaucratic world we live in. The KBR team are well organised and this process is a mere formality as part of their wider preparations. New toilet blocks installed correctly with appropriately sized leach drains are on the list for approval, to ensure the proverbial doesn't hit the fan on 2nd October.

Some mixed results on the winter sports front over the past few weeks. Well done to the Kulin Netball Club on making the CDNA Grand Final going down narrowly against some tough competition. Unfortunately, the KKFC Blues were bundled out in the semis a few weekends ago. Last Saturday saw Kulin Golf Club host the annual Clayton Cup, and the course came up magnificently for the field of over 40. Thanks to Ambrose and the crew for all the work they've put into the course in recent months. Good luck to KDHS students in the Annual Faction Athletics Carnival this Friday, again Ambrose and the crew have been working hard to get the oval in pristine condition for the day.

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## LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS 16 OCTOBER 2021

Nominations are called for the Shire of Kulin Local Government Elections, to be held on **Saturday 16 October 2021** to fill vacancies on the Council.

### What is involved?

As a Councillor you would be involved in running an organisation with the responsibility of making decisions that have a major impact on our lifestyle. As a representative of your community you will find the role enjoyable, challenging and stimulating with involvement in matters as diverse as recreation, libraries, the environment, town planning, health, roads and many more. Meeting fees and some expenses are paid.

### Who can nominate?

Any person who is an Australian Citizen over the age of 18 years who is an elector of the district and is not disqualified under the *Local Government Act 1995* may nominate for council. It is not a requirement that a candidate lives or owns property in the ward for which they nominate (if wards used).

### Nomination Time and Place

- Nominations for all vacancies open on **Thursday, 2 September 2021**
- Nominations must be lodged by **4.00pm, Thursday, 9 September 2021**
- Nominations must be lodged at any time during the above period at the Shire of Kulin Administration Office.

### Nomination Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the RETURNING OFFICER:

- a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Shire Office or via the website [www.kulin.wa.gov.au](http://www.kulin.wa.gov.au)
- a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs. The profile may include a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).
- a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, or postal order, or bank cheque) subject to Returning Officer approval.
- A recent passport size photograph (optional).
- Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or emailed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

# MEDIA RELEASE - wesCARpade

WA's happiest outback motoring adventure, wesCarpade, is coming to town! Camp Quality's famous wesCarpade isn't a car race or a rally – it is a party with a purpose, and it is rolling across WA from September 3-10.

The event is made up of 19 teams driving decorated cars 20+ years old to raise much needed funds for children's cancer charity Camp Quality. Starting in Bunbury and finishing in Perth, the cars will ride a 2065km route, passing through Boyup Brook, Katanning, Dumbleyung, Hyden, Southern Cross, Merredin and Cunderdin. On the 5th of September they will be passing through Kulin. So keep an eye out for wesCARpade.

This year marks the 10th year of wesCarpade, with many participants coming back year after year for the mateship, adventures, and beautiful outback

scenery, but most importantly to raise funds for kids impacted by cancer and their families.

One such participant is Darren Kenny, who will take on wesCarpade for the sixth time this year. Camp Quality is a cause close to his heart and he is aiming to raise \$25,000 in his car, Casey's Kombi, named after his friends' daughter.

"My friend's daughter Casey was diagnosed with a brain tumour years ago and so we saw how hard that was and the help and generosity they got. That made us decide we wanted to do something to give back and wesCarpade was a great way to do that. The fellowship from the other entrants and the celebrating the fundraising for Camp Quality is what keeps me coming back year after year."

Darren Kenny has fundraised in various ways including helping run the Bunbury golf day.

Tessa Litton, Fundraising Coordinator at Camp Quality says, "We are so excited to be running wesCarpade for the 10th year and can't wait to get on the road. All the teams have put their heart and soul into fundraising the past year and are having a real impact on the lives of kids facing cancer through Camp Quality's services and programs".

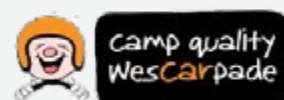

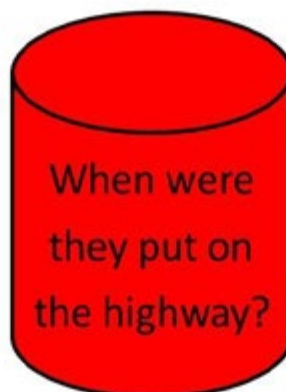
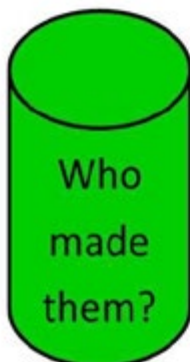

## **School Bus Services review announced**

**23 August 2021**

Member for Central Wheatbelt Hon Mia Davies MLA has welcomed the announcement that the Public Accounts Committee will consider a review into the current regulations and guidelines for School Bus Services (SBS) after colleague Hon Peter Rundle MLA Shadow Minister for Education and Training repeatedly brought this issue to the attention of our State Parliament.

“In the last four years our country MP’s have been dealing with an ever-growing number of concerns about access to school buses,” said Ms Davies.

“The review will be an opportunity for rural families that face challenges accessing the service, and contractors that provide this valuable service.”

Ms Davies said the service provided transport assistance to more than 25,000 rural students on 967 services across regional Western Australia to enable students to attend school regularly.

“The guidelines deciding who is an eligible student and where a bus stops were formulated in 1999, and my electorate office have received an increasing number of complaints from parents throughout the Central Wheatbelt over the last four years,” said Ms Davies.

“Some of the decisions about where a bus stops and who is eligible are resulting in parents having to drive long distances or being forced to leave employment because they cannot access the bus route that will take their child to school.”

Currently for a student to be eligible on a SBS they must be enrolled at their nearest appropriate school, regularly use the school bus, live more than 4.5kms from their school, and reside outside a designated public transport area.

Students who are not eligible for transport assistance may be allowed to travel as complimentary passengers but that is subject to several conditions.

Hon Peter Rundle MLA said education is fundamental for every child in this State, and parents and carers should not have to worry about how their child will get to school.

“I am happy the review has been agreed to and I look forward to taking part and putting the issues and concerns of Regional West Australians at the forefront,” said Mr Rundle.

“I do have some concerns that the Committee is limited to reviewing the contracts within the current funding parameters, especially with the State Government sitting on such a significant budget surplus.”

Ms Davies said the Public Accounts Committee would provide details of the review and encouraged parents, P&Cs, contractors, and community members to make their views known when calls for submissions opened.

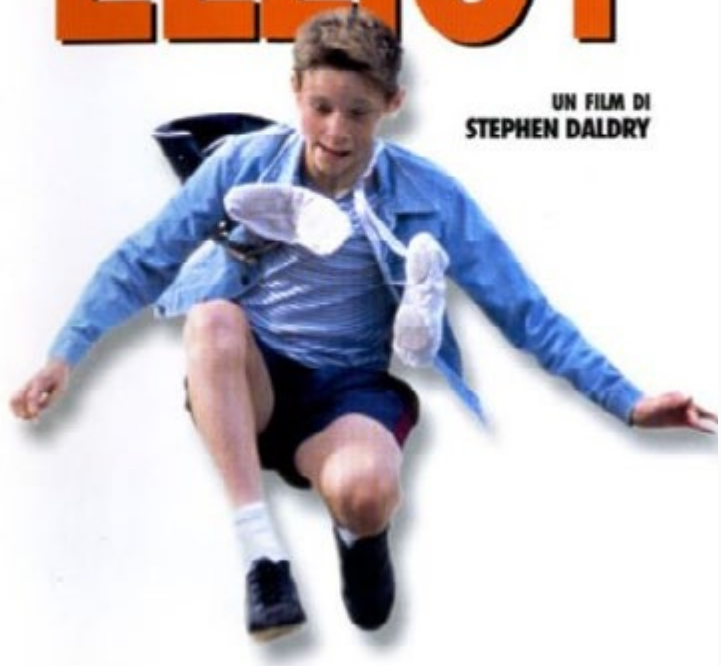
