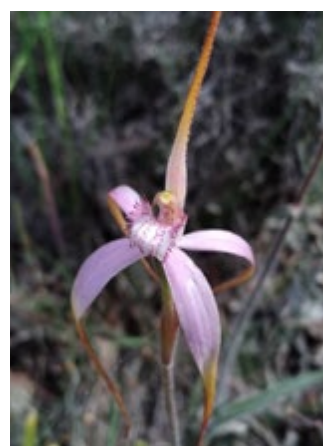
There are over 60 wattles flowering in Kulin Shire, just in September. Find a favourite and check in November for a pod that will give you 3-10 seeds to grow. The **Kulin Wattle, *Acacia kulinensis***, can be seen at the water catchment.

Please NOT the Cootamundra, Australia's Emblem or the Flinders Range as they are killing ours.

Where to start? With colours in all directions, it was hard to concentrate on just orchids last weekend. A dozen Coasties from Albany to Gingin were joined by locals and searched rocks, woodlands and scrub for orchids. They were richly rewarded and we have new listings for our wheatbelt. Vanilla or Lemon Scented Sun Orchids, *Thelymitra antennifera*, are in moss-beds on granite or in gritty sands on flats. Cowslips, *Caladenia flava*, appear everywhere. The Purple Enamels, *Elythranthera brunonis* may hide under sheoaks or stand out in the sun in sand or clay.

Our tourists: WA coasties or Eastern Staters are amazed by the range of our shapes and colours. How can they grow in this exposed gravel ? is a common query. You can grow these too and save heaps of work and water. The more rabbits and roos prune them the more they flower. Many of these have flowered each time we have had rain this year so they can be controlled to flower several times. If you want a certain shade you need to set cuttings rather than seeds.

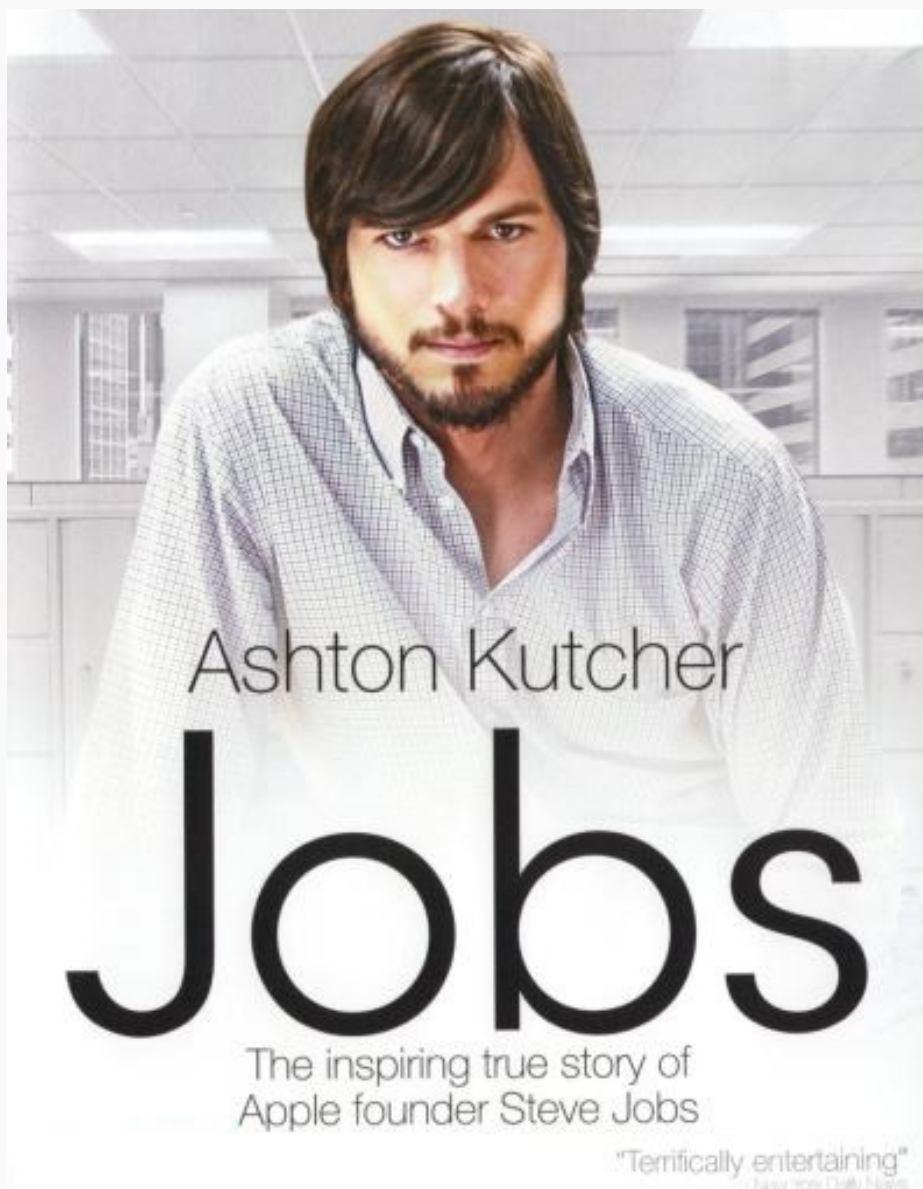
